Friday 4th & 18th - 11:00 AM – “BODY BOARDING”

Come join us as we learn about beach safety and have fun body boarding on our waves. You may bring your own board or we can provide one for you.

Friday 4th & 18th 10:00 AM “BE A TURTLE”

Learn how to interpret all the information that is on a sea turtle nest stake and share it with others. Fill out a Junior Ranger Data Sheet and determine a hatching date.

Friday 11th & 25th - 11:00 AM – “ KITE FLYING”

Come join us as we fly kites to learn more about the wonderful wind the ocean provides for us. You may bring your own or we can provide one for you.

Friday 11th - 10:00 AM - “BEACH WALK”

Discover gifts from the sea on a walk on the shore. We’ll look for seashells, driftwood and other wonderful surprises. Be sure to put on sun screen and bring plenty of water.

Wednesday 23rd -10:00 AM “THE SEA TURTLES ARE HERE”

Find out the current numbers of sea turtles nests on your national seashore. Learn about the 4 different species that use our shores to lay their eggs.
