COMMERCIAL HARVESTING PERMIT EVENT AT SEMINOLE REST

Commercial Harvesting Permits for Canaveral National Seashore/Merritt Island Wildlife Refuge will be issued during a special two day event at the Seminole Rest visitor center located east of US-1 in Oak Hill on River Road. (In Oakhill, turn east onto Halifax Avenue, which is located by the flashing caution light on US-1. Take Halifax Avenue east to River Road. Turn north on River Road. Seminole Rest is two tenths of a mile on the east side of River Road, on October 30th & 31st. Permits will be issued on both days from 10:00 am until 2:00 pm. In order to obtain a permit on either day, applicants must bring a completed permit application with them, and a legible copy of your current SPL (special products fishing license) and commercial boat registrations (if applicable). Commercial Harvesting Permit applications are available on our park website in the permit section. Please print out the application & have it filled out before you arrive. No copier services will be available at Seminole Rest, so you will need to complete your application in advance, and bring it with you in order to obtain your permit the same day. This event is being held to accommodate applicants who were unable to apply for their permit during the recent government shutdown.
