

# BACKCOUNTRY CAMPING

To foster visitor appreciation of the outstanding ecological values and recreational opportunities that comprise Canaveral National Seashore, primitive campsites are available by permit only.

**A PERMIT IS REQUIRED and THERE IS A FEE TO CAMP IN THE SEASHORE.** Campsites are \$20/night. **YOU MUST MAKE A RESERVATION AND OBTAIN A PERMIT USING** [www.Recreation.gov](http://www.Recreation.gov) or by calling (877) 444-6777. You may reserve your site up to six (6) months prior to camp date or up to the first day you wish to camp, if site is available. Only one permit will be issued per site, per night. All information collected on the camping permit is for use by Canaveral National Seashore to ensure that you have a safe and fun backcountry experience. You must be 18 years of age to make a reservation in your name. **CAMPING IS PERMITTED ONLY AT DESIGNATED SITES.** Please note that violations of these regulations may result in fines.

**NO FACILITIES OR UTILITIES EXIST** at any of the campsites within Canaveral National Seashore. Leave No Trace camping ethics are the rule.

**THERE IS NO VEHICLE CAMPING** at the park. Recreational vehicle campsites are available at other locations in Brevard and Volusia Counties. Camping or biodegradable toilet paper is recommended. It is available at various retailers or at Apollo Visitor Center for nominal fee.

## ISLAND CAMPING

Natural island campsites and spoil island sites provide a variety of access and capacity options to those visitors who have their own boat, canoe, or kayak. Please see the attached map for location and site numbers/names. **RESERVATIONS** and a permit **ARE REQUIRED** for island campsites. Canoe rentals are available for sites one through five. These are reserved by calling the Visitor Center (386) 428-3384 ext. 0, after you have made your camping reservation. Sites 6-14 may only be reached with a personal boat, canoe or kayak.

## HAVE FUN - SAFELY

Plan your trip in advance, with special attention to travel routes and weather forecasts. Be sure that your vessel is fueled and equipped for emergencies, and that all passengers are issued appropriate personal flotation devices. Always share your intended agenda with a friend or family member other than those in your party. Do not leave valuables in your vehicle.

We recommend having a cellular telephone at your disposal while camping in the park. For questions or directions call (386) 428-3384 ext. 0. Emergencies should be reported by dialing 911.

Firewood is not available at campsites: please provide your own firewood or cook stove. Please be aware of special restrictions concerning open fires. Ask a Park Ranger about current fire danger conditions. Thank you!

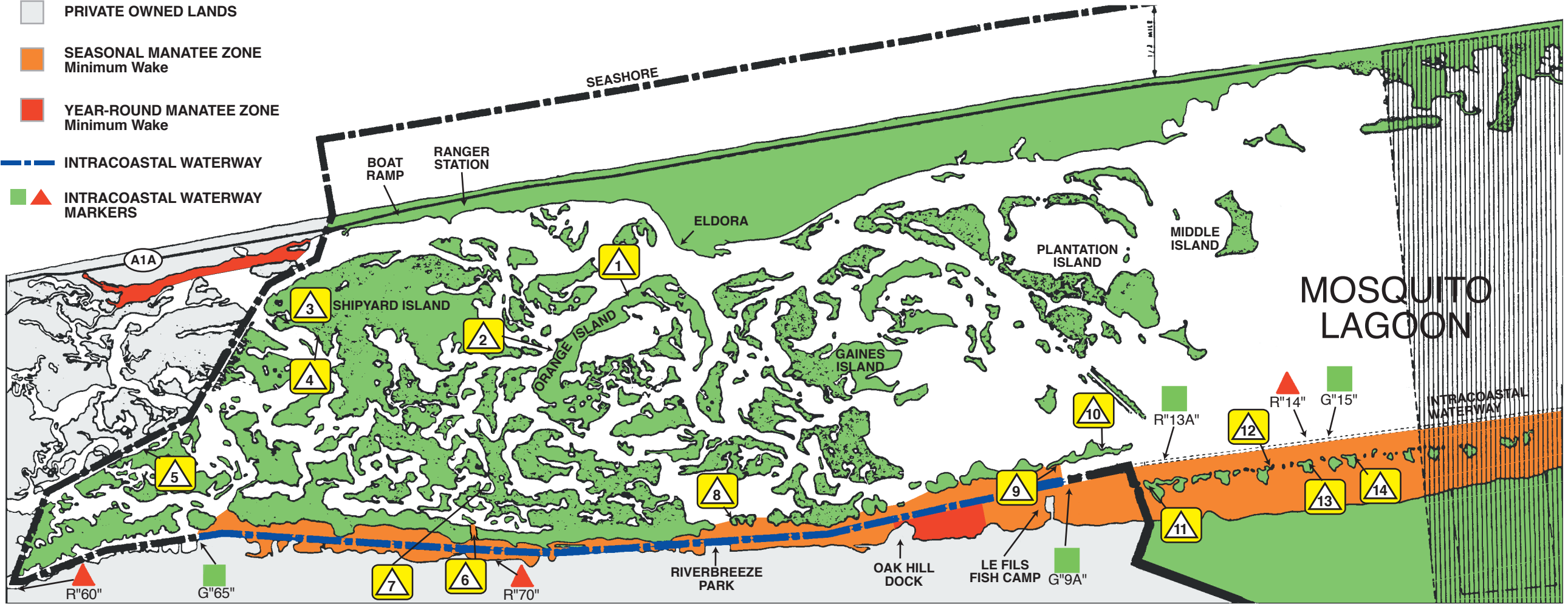
