Friday, April 8th & 15th - 9:00 AM “A WALK IN THE PARK – Seminole Rest”– Walk with a ranger for fun and exercise. Explore the grounds that were inhabited for centuries by the Timucua and see the turn of the century homes that helped save the mound. Meet along the Seminole Rest trail. (1 hour)

Saturday, April 9th -10:00 AM “CAST NETTING AT PLAYALINDA” – Join a ranger and learn the art of cast netting. See how to catch bait and see what may be caught in this area of Mosquito Lagoon. Meet at Eddy Creek dock. (1 hour)

Wednesday, April 27th – 10:00 AM “BEACH CLEAN-UP” – Join a ranger in keeping our coasts clean. Bring water, hat, sunscreen and bug spray. Trash bags are provided. Meet at parking lot #7. (1 hour)
