### PLAYALINDA DISTRICT INTERPRETIVE PROGRAMS MARCH 2016

All programs meet the requirements for the Canaveral National Seashore Junior Ranger Program.

**Tuesday, March 1<sup>st</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup> - 9:00 AM “A WALK IN THE PARK – Seminole Rest”**– Walk with a ranger for fun and exercise. Explore the grounds that were inhabited for centuries by the Timucua and see the turn of the century homes that helped save the mound. Meet along the Seminole Rest trail. (1 hour)

**Friday, March 4<sup>th</sup> -10:00 AM “CAST NETTING AT PLAYALINDA”** – Join a ranger and learn the art of cast netting. See how to catch bait and see what may be caught in this area of Mosquito Lagoon. Meet at Eddy Creek dock. (1 hour)

**Saturday, March 5<sup>th</sup> – 10:00 AM “PLANT WALK”** - Join a ranger who will identify the flora and fauna and their unique characteristics. Bring water, sunscreen, bug repellent, and a hat. Meet at Eddy Creek. (1 hour)

**Friday, March 11<sup>th</sup> – 7:30 PM- 11:00 PM “NIGHT SKY EXPLORATION”** - Explore the celestial sky with a ranger and the Brevard Astronomical Society and the NASA Amateur Astronomy Club. Telescopes will be available for viewing the night sky. Dress for the weather. Bring bug repellent, water/snack, and maybe a lawn chair. Flashlights that emit red light are welcome. Call 321- 867-4078 to reserve your spot. Reservations begin March 1<sup>st</sup>.

**RESERVATIONS REQUIRED** and **SPACE IS LIMITED**. Meet at the park entrance. We will leave promptly at 7:30 PM, weather permitting.

**Saturday, March 19<sup>th</sup> – 10:00 AM “JR RANGER BEACH TREASURE HUNT”**- Join a ranger and hunt for natural treasures. Walk the beach for fun and exercise. Discuss the significance of the seashore along the way. Bring water, hat and sunscreen. Meet at Eddy Creek. (1 hour)
