DATES: April 1 - July 15, 2012

RESPONSIBILITIES: Campground Hosts assist visitors registering for sites, answer questions and explain park regulations to campers through out the day; report campground status to the Visitor Center staff throughout the day using a hand-held radio; assist with other projects as able and interested. Campground Hosts provide a vital service to the park and contribute greatly to visitor satisfaction.

BENEFITS: Live in the Fruita campground and meet great people! An RV pad with full hook-ups is provided along with utilities (water, electricity and garbage). Also provided are small per diem payments for days worked. Training and uniforms are provided. Take orientation trips around the park with staff.
