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HISTORY

Cane River Creole National Historical Park (hereafter CARI) was authorized by the United States Congress on November 2, 1994 (Public Law 103-449) through the Cane River Creole National Historical Park and National Heritage Area Act (16 USC 410ccc). Covering more than 62 acres, it comprises two park units---Magnolia Plantation and Oakland Plantation---and includes 70 historic structures. The purpose of the park, according to its foundation document, is to "preserve and protect" the plantations and "the resources of the Cane River region," while "[enhancing] the understanding of its peoples and regions."

Originally inhabited by the Natchitoches people of the Caddoan linguistic group, the Cane River area of Louisiana was claimed by French King Louis XIV (1638 – 1715). With French settlement sparse compared to that of the English North American colonies, some settlers were able to acquire significant land. Two such men were Jean Baptiste Lecomte and Jean Baptiste Prud'homme, who, although starting with a mere 8 and 9 acres in 1753 and 1758, respectively, steadily built up their holdings along Cane River. After the Louisiana Purchase (1803), which transferred the Cane River region and its resources and peoples to the United States, their descendants continued to accumulate lands, which culminated in the establishment of Magnolia Plantation (1835) and Oakland Plantation (originally Bermuda, 1867).

Similar to other antebellum southern plantations, Magnolia and Oakland were meant to be self-sustaining commercial enterprises. They primarily produced cotton, the principal southern cash crop, for national and global markets, but also foodstuffs, livestock, and timber. Due to the rich alluvial soil, the riverbanks were the best areas for cotton production, while interior tracts provided lumber and hunting grounds. Because Cane River was part of the main channel of the Red River for much of the nineteenth century, steamboats docking nearby could ship plantation goods downriver to New Orleans for sale.

Both plantations depended upon African American enslaved labor. According the 1860 census, 7,800-acre Magnolia, belonging to the Lecomtes, included 235 enslaved persons, while Prud'homme-owned Oakland, with 3,400 acres (of which only 1,000 were cultivated), had 147. Enslaved peoples at Oakland and Magnolia plantations worked in a gang system, a brutally efficient method of organization which placed them under the direct, constant supervision of an overseer; these conditions offered the enslaved only minimal free time at their enslavers' convenience or whims. Kept under the scrutiny of the French colonial code noire, enslaved men, women, and children in the Cane River area fared no better under southern state law. Although the Lecomtes and Prud'hommes emancipated a few, the majority of enslaved persons were bound to labor for the entirety of their lives.

Southern secession and civil war (1860-1865) challenged this world. Alphonse Prud'homme and Emile Touissant Hertzog (a Lecomte descendant) joined the Confederate Army and fought in several battles. The Confederate government taxed and requisitioned goods from Magnolia and Oakland plantations for the war effort. The United States' naval blockade, solidified by the capture of New Orleans in 1862, contributed to spiraling inflation in Louisiana. Finally, United States forces invaded during the Red River Campaign (March – May 1864), burning the main house at Magnolia, the cotton gin at Oakland, and more than 900 bales of cotton.

Following the Confederacy's collapse and the abolition of slavery, Cane River plantations adjusted to a

"free" labor system. Many formerly enslaved peoples stayed on as tenant farmers and sharecroppers, although in reality they were indebted peons subjected to segregation and abuse. Meanwhile plantation lands were successively subdivided amongst heirs. The Prud'homme holdings, for example, were split in 1873 between the sons of Phanor Prud'homme, with Jacques Alphonse retaining the west bank property, which included Oakland.

Boll weevil infestations, cheaper markets elsewhere, and economic depression in the first half of the twentieth century ended the southern cotton boom. Moreover, the contemporaneous "Great Migration" of African Americans to northern cities reduced the labor supply. After the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers dammed Cane River in 1915 to create a recreational lake, Magnolia and Oakland plantations became inaccessible to river traffic. Management of the properties became increasingly challenging for the Hertzog-Lecomtes and Prud'hommes. Following the death of Matt Hertzog II in 1973, a separate corporation assumed responsibility for farming at Magnolia.

Preservation at Magnolia Plantation had begun in 1976 when the Hertzogs donated 19 acres including 21 buildings to Museum Contents, Inc., a local non-profit organization. Both Magnolia and Oakland were designated National Historic Landmarks in 1979. Heritage tourism at the plantations had mostly been seasonal, at the discretion of the landowners.

About the same time, heritage organizations started to show interest in the area. In fact, Lucille Prud'homme had helped found the Association of Natchitoches Women for the Preservation of Historic Natchitoches (later, the Association for the Preservation of Historic Natchitoches [APHN]) as early as 1941. Alongside another organization, the Saint Augustine Historical Society (SAHS), which focused on preserving Creole-style vernacular architecture, the APHN became part of the Cane River National Heritage Area Commission. Louisiana's congressional members lent their support to the Commission's efforts to protect, maintain, and interpret antebellum houses along the river. These efforts culminated in the establishment of CARI in 1994.

The park gradually took shape as parcels of land were transferred to the National Park Service, beginning with 19 acres from Museum Contents, Inc., in January 1996. The following November, the Prud'hommes transferred 42 acres of Oakland. Other transfers took place during 1997 and 1998. Historic structures (designated as part of the park's List of Classified Structures [LCS]) transferred from Oakland include the Main House (built 1818), Plantation Store, Doctor's House, Carpenter's Shop, Overseers' Quarters, and a number of Slave Quarters; those from Magnolia include the Plantation Store, Blacksmith Shop, Slave Hospital and Cabins, and Cotton Gin. (At present, the Main House at Magnolia remains in private hands.) CARI officially opened to the public in October 1999.

Since the park's establishment, the NPS has focused on improving access and identifying key natural and cultural resources. In July 1996, with the approval of the United States Senate, \$5.6 million was made available for stabilization and repair of historic structures and refurbishing of exhibits. A 2001 general management plan (GMP) recommended direct public engagement at Oakland, via ranger-led tours and "living history" demonstrations; at Magnolia, by contrast, there was to be a minimal park footprint (apart from adding a parking lot), allowing visitors a more contemplative experience. Inventories were taken between 2001 and 2006 of items left in the plantation buildings, resulting in a catalog of between 500,000 and 1,000,000 museum objects and archival documents. In 2002 the Historic American Buildings Survey (HABS) completed a project on the Main House at Magnolia. More recently, CARI staff undertook extensive vegetation management work in 2018-2019 and repaired damage done by Hurricane Laura in

2020.
