



## Connect the Digestive Organ with its Name and Function

### Organ Functions

Makes & releases juice into small intestine to make food nutrients less acid.

Takes up any left over water, vitamins & electrolytes (like sodium & chloride) in food waste.

Moves the food around in the mouth to help break it down and mix it with saliva.

Long, muscular tube that squeezes food down into the stomach.

Digestion finishes up here & all the nutrients are absorbed into blood.


A storage tank for digesting food by mixing it with powerful acids to kills bacteria & break it down (protein digestion begins).

Makes & releases a chemical that breaks down starchy foods (like bread).

Stores bile made in the liver.

Makes bile to break down fat. cleanses blood & changes nutrients into forms the body can use and store.
