

Rules for Visiting

Castillo de San Marcos National Monument receives 700,000 visitors each year. Of those, about 60,000 are students visiting for Educational purposes. While visiting the Castillo please observe the following so that all our visitors may enjoy it as well.

- Please stay together as a group and with your Teachers or Chaperones.
- Visit quietly and be attentive as if you were still in your classroom.

For your Safety

- Watch your children at all times. Especially up stairs on the Gundeck as there are no guard rails.
- Stay alert as you walk on uneven floors.

Help preserve our National Mounment by

- Not climbing on the walls.
- Not climbing on our Cannons.
- Only water is allowed to be consumed in the Castillo. Please secure all other drinks and foods before entering.

General Information

- The bus spaces in Castillo's parking lot are for unloading and loading only. Bus parking can be found at the city garage on West Castillo Drive.
- Only the lower level of the Castillo is wheelchair accessible.
- If you plan on picnicking on our grounds please plan on cleaning up after your group.
- Please don't feed the animals.
- Keep hydrated, contact a Ranger if anyone is showing signs of heat related illness.
