It has been compiled by park biologists from the park's scant museum collection and various other sources, including researchers and specialists who have generously shared their observations informally or in publications, including Eric Metzler (Lepidoptera, moths), Robert Larsen (Odonata), Shann Stringer (Diptera, Chironomidae), John Abbott (Odonata, misc.), Stephen Cary and Richard Holland (Lepidoptera, butterflies), Gavin Emmons (Lepidoptera, butterflies), Nick Grishin (Lepidoptera and Diptera), Ed Gage (Coleoptera, Cicindelidae), Bruce Walsh (Lepidoptera, moths), and others.
