

Be A National Park Ranger This Summer!



Teacher-Ranger-Teacher Program



Put on the Ranger uniform, receive training, and work for the National Park Service at Capulin Volcano National Monument for eight weeks between June and August; then bring your experience back to the classroom to share with your students.

The Teacher-Ranger-Teacher will have the opportunity to work on various projects and activities including, but not limited to, conducting Junior Ranger and interpretive programs, writing curriculum-based school activities, participating in outreach efforts, working behind the information desk at the Visitor Center, and assisting with resource management projects.

Teachers receive a \$300/week stipend, a uniform, and housing at the park (if needed); housing is in a shared quarters with other seasonal staff members.
