

In early 1862, Gen. Thomas J. "Stonewall" Jackson, commander of Confederate forces in the Shenandoah Valley, was ordered to prevent Union forces in the Valley from moving east to join Gen. George B. McClellan's push on Richmond. In one of military history's most brilliant campaigns, Jackson, with 18,000 men by mid-campaign, kept three Union armies – almost 60,000 troops – at bay, helping to save the Confederacy's capital from capture early in the war.



On March 3, 2012, the Shenandoah Valley Battlefields Foundation will kick off the 150th Anniversary commemoration of that historic campaign with "A chapter in history...without parallel": Perspectives on Stonewall Jackson's Valley Campaign, a Sesquicentennial conference featuring renowned Civil War historians and authors Ed Bearss, Brandon H. Beck, Peter Cozzens, Gary L. Ecelbarger, and Jonathan Noyalas.

The conference will be held at Shenandoah University in Winchester, and will feature five lectures, a panel discussion, and book signing. The cost to attend is \$20 per person. Space will be limited, so early registrations are encouraged. Sign up today!
