### **César E. Chávez National Monument Celebrated Anniversary with 130 Fourth Graders**

César E. Chávez National Monument, in cooperation with the National Park Foundation, hosted an Every Kid in a Park event on October 8, 2015, from 9:30 a.m.-11 a.m., in celebration of the monument's third anniversary. A total of 130 students from two Central Valley schools—Harvest Elementary School (Delano, CA) and Di Giorgio Elementary School (Arvin, CA)—participated in the event. Students completed new Junior Ranger booklets in the visitor center, desert garden, and memorial garden.

The Every Kid in a Park pass allows kids in the fourth grade free entrance to national parks, national forests, national wildlife refuges, and more!
