Artillery Demonstration at Point Park

Fort Oglethorpe, Georgia: Chickamauga and Chattanooga National Military Park invites the public to attend a special Living History artillery demonstration at Point Park on Lookout Mountain on Sunday, September 2, 2012.

The artillery programs will be presented at 10:30 AM, 12:00 Noon, 1:30 PM, and 2:30 PM. A park ranger who will describe the drills and activities required to fire an artillery piece, while explaining the teamwork necessary for the weapon to be successfully effective. Visitors are encouraged to observe and meet with the different crew members of the unit to learn what life was like for these soldiers during the Civil War.
