### **Ochs Museum and Trails Reopen October 1, 2011**

Fort Oglethorpe, Georgia: The Ochs Museum at Point Park on Lookout Mountain, as well as trails leading to the museum will reopen on Saturday, October 1, 2011. New aggregate concrete walkways have been laid and handrails repaired. The new concrete surface will provide a much safer experience for park visitors and will be more attractive and sustainable than the former asphalt surface.

The connector routes such as the Bluff and Mountain Beautiful trails will also reopen on Saturday to provide access to the Ochs Museum or Point Park from Sunset Rock and the Cravens House.
