### Temporary Road closure at Chickamauga and Chattanooga National Military Park

Fort Oglethorpe, Georgia: Chickamauga and Chattanooga National Military Park will be repaving a portion of Alexander Bridge Road from Jays Mill Road to Alexander Bridge, starting December 5, 2011 at 7:00 am. The following roads will be closed, 1) Alexander Bridge Road East of Jays Mill Road and 2) Viniard Alexander Road. The repaving work is planned to be completed by Friday, December 9, 2011 with a possible extension due to inclement weather. Alexander Bridge Road to Viniard Alexander and Viniard Alexander will be reopened upon the completion of the work. The Alexander Bridge project is continuing as scheduled.
