### Time Change Reminder: Hours at Chickamauga and Chattanooga National Military Park

Fort Oglethorpe, Georgia: As a reminder on Sunday, November 6, 2011, most of the Country will revert back to Standard Time. As always, all units of Chickamauga and Chattanooga National Military Park are open from 6:00 a.m. until sunset. Since it will be getting darker earlier, the public is reminded to continue to exit the park units at sunset each day.

The Chickamauga Battlefield Visitor Center is open from 8:30 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. and the Lookout Mountain Battlefield Visitor Center is open from 9:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m., every day of the week, except Christmas, December 25.
