



“A New Deal for Platt National Park”

Historic Candlelight Tour



Celebrate the 75th anniversary of the Civilian Conservation Corps (CCC) by learning more about the work CCC Company 808 completed in Platt National Park [the present-day Platt Historic District in Chickasaw National Recreation Area] in the 1930s.

WHAT: Free guided-tours through a series of vignettes presented by park staff and volunteers dressed in period costume depicting scenes from the 1930s. Tours will be escorted on a half-mile walk through the historic Bromide Pavilion area of the park, where one thousand luminaries will light the path.

WHEN: Saturday, October 18, 2008; 6:00PM until 9:00PM
Tours will leave every 20 minutes beginning at 6:00PM and last approximately 50 minutes. *Reservations are required.*

WHERE: Tours begin at the Arbuckle Historical Society / Old City Hall Building in downtown Sulphur, Oklahoma.
