### Welcome!

Reservations are not accepted for the 25 individual campsites. Self-pay and registration; Take a fee envelope from the box and find an open campsite; Complete registration envelope and return here with payment to pipe safe within one hour of occupying your campsite.

### Regulations & Reminders

- Maximum RV/motorhome or trailer length is 29 feet, actual measurements.
- Fee is \$12 per night; Interagency Senior/Golden Age and Access pass owners pay \$6. Accepted Payment: Cash; Personal Check Written to Chiricahua National Monument/NPS; Discover, Visa, or MasterCard credit cards.
- Maximum of 8 people, 2 tents, and 2 vehicles per site. Use tent pads when setting up tents.
- Checkout time is 11:00 am.
- Quiet hours are 8:00 pm to 8:00 am.
- Site #8 is designed for people with disabilities, but open to anyone for one night if it is the last available site.
- Group site is for groups of 9 to 24 people; maximum of 8 tents, no trailers or RVs; \$3/person/night; 5 vehicles.

### For Your Safety

- Never leave fires unattended; make sure they are completely out; cold ashes belong in the metal, fireproof buckets.
- Do not feed, approach, or disturb wildlife.
- Use the bear-proof boxes for food and any scented items if you don't have a secure vehicle.
- Pets must not be left unattended, and need to always be on a leash. The Silver Spur Meadow Trail is open for walking your dog.

### Prohibited

- Ground fires
- Wood gathering
- Day use picnicking
- Saving or subletting sites
- Skateboards, roller blades, scooters
- Solar showers, clotheslines, and hammocks
- Washing dishes or bathing at water spigots


