POSITION DESCRIPTION

Title: **Volunteer Campground Host**

Supervisor: Park Ranger – Visitor Services
Base Wage: Volunteer, with benefits
Hours: 20 hours per week
Start: May 1 (negotiable)
End: September 15 (negotiable)
Schedule: Negotiable, weekends and holidays are preferred

Location:

Volunteer Hosts may choose to serve at the full-service Smoky Mountain Campground of Castle Rocks State Park, located just outside City of Rocks National Reserve and near the visitor center and community of Almo, or at the primitive campground within the Reserve at Bath Rock.

Duties:

1. Greet visitors
2. Provide park information
3. Educate visitors to park rules and encourage compliance with fees
4. Respond to emergencies (or notify park ranger of an emergency)
5. Assist Visitor Services with managing reservations
6. Sell firewood at the host site
7. Perform special projects based on personal interests and talents

Compensation:

Volunteer hosts receive uniforms, training, Workers Compensation Coverage, occupancy of a full service RV site, access to laundry facilities, annual state parks pass, free refills on propane, discounts on park souvenirs and books, and use of the nearby City of Rocks National Reserve library.
