**Title:** Park Interpreter  
**Supervisor:** Park Ranger – Visitor Services  
**Base Wage:** \$9.00 per hour  
**Hours:** 600 hours  
**Start:** May 18  
**End:** September 6  
**Schedule:** 40 hours a week, most weekends, evenings and holidays, may include split shifts and flexible scheduling to meet program needs.

**Purpose:**

(1) To fulfill the mission of the Reserve, which includes "...interpreting its values..." and (2) To interpret and promote understanding of the six nationally significant resources of the Reserve, according to the established interpretive themes

**Duties:**

1. Research, develop, schedule, and deliver thematic interpretive presentations
2. Provide interpretive presentations to schools and community groups
3. Create curriculum-based educational programs for visiting school groups
4. Conduct Junior Ranger programs weekly
5. Provide "shoulder"-season customer service at the visitor center
6. Plan and conduct park-sponsored special events
7. Produce interpretive materials for bulletin boards, wayside exhibits, brochures and park websites
8. Assist the Park Ranger – Visitor Services with special projects

**Minimum Qualifications:**

1. Legal U.S. resident, 18 years old or older, with valid driver's License
2. High School Diploma or equivalent (college coursework or degree preferred)
3. Ability to communicate effectively with the public
4. Skills in Microsoft Office applications and A/V Equipment
5. Skills in interpretive writing and desktop publishing
6. Ability to work outdoors in a variety of weather conditions and terrain

1. Ability to work alone, self-motivated
2. Ability to deliver interpretive presentations to diverse audiences
