

## POSITION DESCRIPTION

**Title:** Youth Conservation Corps Team Leader

**Supervisor:** Park Ranger – Natural Resources  
**Base Wage:** \$9.00 per hour  
**Hours:** 344 hours  
**Start:** May 14, 2012  
**End:** August 3, 2012  
**Schedule:** 40-hour weeks, generally 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

**Purpose:**

To supervise 3 or 4 15-18 year old students in the YCC program working on maintenance and resource projects within City of Rocks National Reserve and Castle Rocks State Park.

**Description of the Youth Conservation Corps Program:**

The program gives young people the opportunity to work in a park on projects that help the park meet its mission of preserving and protecting natural and cultural resources while managing recreation. The City of Rocks National Reserve and Castle Rocks State Park will host several NPS and academic researchers this summer. This will provide the YCC participants an opportunity to engage in assisting the researchers and hearing about their careers. **Duties:**

1. Supervise 3 or 4 YCC participants (15-18 years old). This includes coordinating with the chiefs of maintenance, trails, visitor services, and natural and cultural resources for work assignments and completing administrative tasks such as hiring paperwork and time sheets
2. Other tasks as assigned

**Minimum Qualifications:**

1. Legal U.S. resident, 21 years old or older, with valid driver's License
2. High School Diploma/GED

**Desired Skills and Certifications:**

1. Ability to supervise teenagers toward the completion of scheduled projects
2. Ability to work as a team and coordinate with multiple departments to organize and manage tasks to keep the work flow going
3. Knowledge and ability to use power tools safely (chainsaw, drills, etc)
4. Ability to use a hand held GPS unit to gather data in the field is a plus
