RULES

- Pay fees at Bath Rock
- Length of stay is limited to 14 days in any 30-day period
- Pets on leash at all times
- Gathering of firewood is prohibited
- Use established campsites and fire rings only
- Quiet hours between 10 pm and 7 am
- Maximum of 8 people, 2 vehicles, and 2 tents per individual campsite

EQUESTRIAN CAMPING

City of Rocks National Reserve offers the Juniper Group Site for equestrian campers. This area is remote and primitive. This area features a corral, standard campsite amenities, and a vault toilet. Smoky Mountain Campground near the east entrance to the reserve offers six sites with water and electricity, paved camping spurs, coral and showers.
