



REQUEST FOR PERMIT TO BOLT

An individual requesting a permit to use a rock drill for the purpose of installing new bolts or replacing existing bolts for use as rock climbing anchors on public lands within the Reserve must submit this form, and the map and photograph as specified in section III. Once a request is received, a field review will be conducted by the Climbing Ranger and a determination will be made within 20 working days. If permission is granted, the applicant will make arrangements with the Climbing Ranger as to the date and time the drilling will occur.
