  - (4/2/1845 – 11/20/1910)
  - Married to Fanny Burwell Nelson
  - “Blessed are the Pure at Heart”
- Child of Fanny and Corbin Mercer/Nelson
  - (9/27/1888 – 4/2/1889)
  - “Our Little Darling”
  - “Suffer little children come unto me”
- Elizabeth Page Nelson
  - (8/10/1918)
  - Daughter of William and Catharine Nelson
  - “At Rest”
- Mary B. Nelson
  - (4/30/1839 – 1/7/1911)
  - “Blessed are the dead that die in the Lord”
- Catharina Nelson
  - (8/11/1835 – 7/30/1896)
  - Daughter of William? And Catharine Nelson
  - “At Rest”
- William Nelson
  - 1/17/1801 – 3/21/1849
  - “Blessed at the dead that die in the Lord”
- Catharine M. Nelson
  - Died 11/4/1840
  - 39 years
  - “Beloved wife of William Nelson”
  - More writing
- William Nelson IV
  - 4/25/1845 – 10/10/1877
  - “Citizen, Soldier, Lawyer, engineer”
  - “Blessed are the dead which die in the Lord”

- General Thomas Nelson Jr.
  - “Patriot, Soldier, Christian-gentleman”
  - 12/18/1738 – 1/2/1789
  - “Mover of the resolution of May 15, 1776 in the Virginia convention”
  - “Instructing her delegates in congress to move that body to declare the colonies free and independent states”
  - “Signer of the declaration of independence”
  - “War governor of Virginia”
  - “Commander of Virginia’s forces”
  - “He gave all for liberty”
