 <u>1872 :</u> Silver found in Surprise Canyon (near Panamint City)	 <u>1874 :</u> Panamint City established. Population = 2000
 <u>1876 :</u> A flash flood destroyed Panamint City but some people continued to live there.	 <u>1877 :</u> Post Office closed in Panamint City.
 <u>1881:</u> Borax found in in the Death Valley area.	 <u>1882 :</u> Harmony Borax town established. Most workers lived in adobe houses or tents. Wages were \$1.25.day for laborers or \$5.00 for blacksmith.
 <u>1885:</u> Harmony Borax mine & town closed.	 <u>1897 :</u> Ballarat town established. Population = 400 in the boom years.
 <u>1898:</u> Radcliffe Mine (Ballarat town) opened.	 <u>1900 :</u> Ballarat post office established.
 <u>1903 :</u> Radcliffe Mine (Ballarat town) stopped producing gold ore. It produced 15,000 tons of gold ore during its lifespan.	 <u>1917 :</u> Ballarat post office closed.

 <u>1904:</u> Gold found in Bullfrog area (Rhyolite town).	 <u>1905 :</u> Rhyolite established. Population = up to 10,000 in the boom years.
 <u>1905 (June):</u> Rhyolite post office opened.	 <u>1911 :</u> Bullfrog area mine closed (Rhyolite town).
 <u>1914:</u> Rhyolite post office closed.	 <u>1905:</u> Copper found in Greenwater area.
 <u>1905 :</u> Greenwater town established. Population = 2000. Water hauled in at \$15 per barrel.	 <u>1909 :</u> Greenwater mines closed.
 <u>1905 (July 2nd):</u> Gold found in Eureka and Cashier mines (Harrisburg town),	 <u>1905 :</u> Harrisburg town established. Population = 300. It was a tent city.
 <u>1910 :</u> Harrisburg town closed.	 <u>1906 :</u> Two miners found gold in Skidoo area. Skidoo town established. Population = 700.
 <u>1906 (July) :</u> Skidoo Post Office opened.	 <u>1913 :</u> Skidoo water pipe broke & stamp mill destroyed by fire.

 <p><u>1917 (September) :</u> Skidoo Post Office closed.</p>	 <p><u>1904 :</u> Gold found in Leadville area but no one mined it more.</p>
 <p><u>1905 :</u> Copper and Lead found in Leadfield area.</p>	 <p><u>1926 (April) :</u> Leadfield town established. Population = 300.</p>
 <p><u>1926 (August) :</u> Post office opened in Leadfield.</p>	 <p><u>1927 (February) :</u> Post office closed in Leadfield.</p>
