Death Valley Sand Dunes Trifold Pamphlet Instructions

Fold the paper in thirds.

You will have six sections to fill in—three sections on each side.

The front page is the only page that should be the same for everyone. It must include a title and a picture related to sand dunes.

The title should be something that would encourage people to visit the sand dunes.

Examples: Sand Dunes Are The Best! Looking For an Adventure? Visit The Sand Dunes! Death Valley Dunes- the Place to Go!

You may choose five out of the seven options below:

- 1. Create a page that shows what animals or animal tracks you saw on the dunes. Draw a picture and write a paragraph about the evidence of animal life on the dunes.
- 2. Create a page that shows what plants you saw on the dunes. Draw a picture and write a paragraph about the evidence of plant life on the dunes.
- 3. Create a page where you draw a map of California and plot Death Valley/ Furnace Creek. Plot the location of the Mesquite Sand Dunes and other sand dunes found in Death Valley National Park. Write a paragraph describing what the Mesquite Sand Dunes are like.
- 4. Create a page about the environment around the dunes. Write several paragraphs about what was around the Mesquite Dunes. Describe what it was like getting to the dunes, walking on the dunes, and playing on the dunes. Describe what you learned and what you think people need to know about the sand dunes in Death Valley National Park.
- 5. Create a page that is full of reminders or suggestions if a person is planning on visiting the sand dunes in Death Valley National Park. Write a paragraph or two about how the time of year and the time of day can influence how hot it is. Make a list of suggested items to leave at home or a list of items to bring. Draw pictures of the items that a person should bring.
- 6. Create a page with the <u>National Park Website Death Valley Sand Dunes</u> link on it. Draw a picture and write a paragraph or two about the things that you saw on the website. https://www.nps.gov/deva/learn/nature/sand-dunes.htm>
- 7. Create a page that describes how a sand dune is made. Draw a picture and write a paragraph about the formation of a sand dune. Be sure to mention weathering, erosion, and deposition.
