

Glen Haven Post -visit

Overview: In this lesson students will reflect on the experiences they had while visiting Glen Haven and connect that experience to current events.

They will recognize the mission of the National Park Service and how it relates to them.

Grade Level: 1st – 5th grade

Duration: About 1 hour

Learning Objectives: After completing this lesson, the student will be able to

Compare life today with life in a maritime village in the past

Recognize their role in remembering (preserving and protecting) the past and recording the present for the benefit of future generations.

National Standards/Content Expectations: Based on grade level content expectations and teacher input

Procedure:

Part 1 – Describe or draw the job you would have had in Glen Haven in 1914. (eg: Shop Keeper)

Part 2 – Describe or draw that job in 2014. (Cashier, Baker, Clerk, Accountant, etc.)

Part 3 – What improvements have been made in your chosen job since 1914?

Or

Send a letter to a teacher or a park ranger explaining what one thing done or built in the past has helped you and what one thing you do or build today will help someone in the future.

Assessment/Evaluation: Students can demonstrate what they have learned by sharing and explaining their choices with the class.
