
## Habitat Scavenger Hunt

**Safety:** Remember to explore in safe areas with an adult's supervision. We recommend daily tick checks after exploring outside. Here is a link to a Maine Tick/Lyme Disease Info Sheet for your reference: <u>Tick Information</u>

**Procedure**: Walk around a safe outside space with adult supervision and make a mark every time you see an example of food, water, shelter, and space. These are what animals need in their habitats to survive. You can write in a little dot, a checkmark, or you can even draw a little picture. Hint: A shelter could be a nest or a house, but remember it could also be the area underneath a log! Try with a partner and compare what you find!

**Wrap up**: Share with your scavenger hunt with your family. What was your favorite thing you saw? Did you notice something you have never noticed before? Try it inside your house too!
