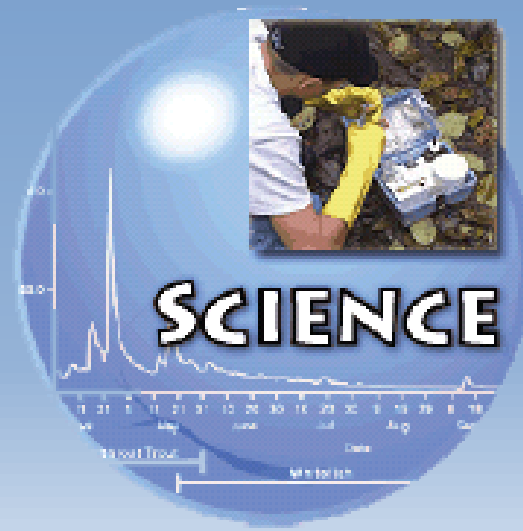


# Habitat Requirements of Pacific Salmon

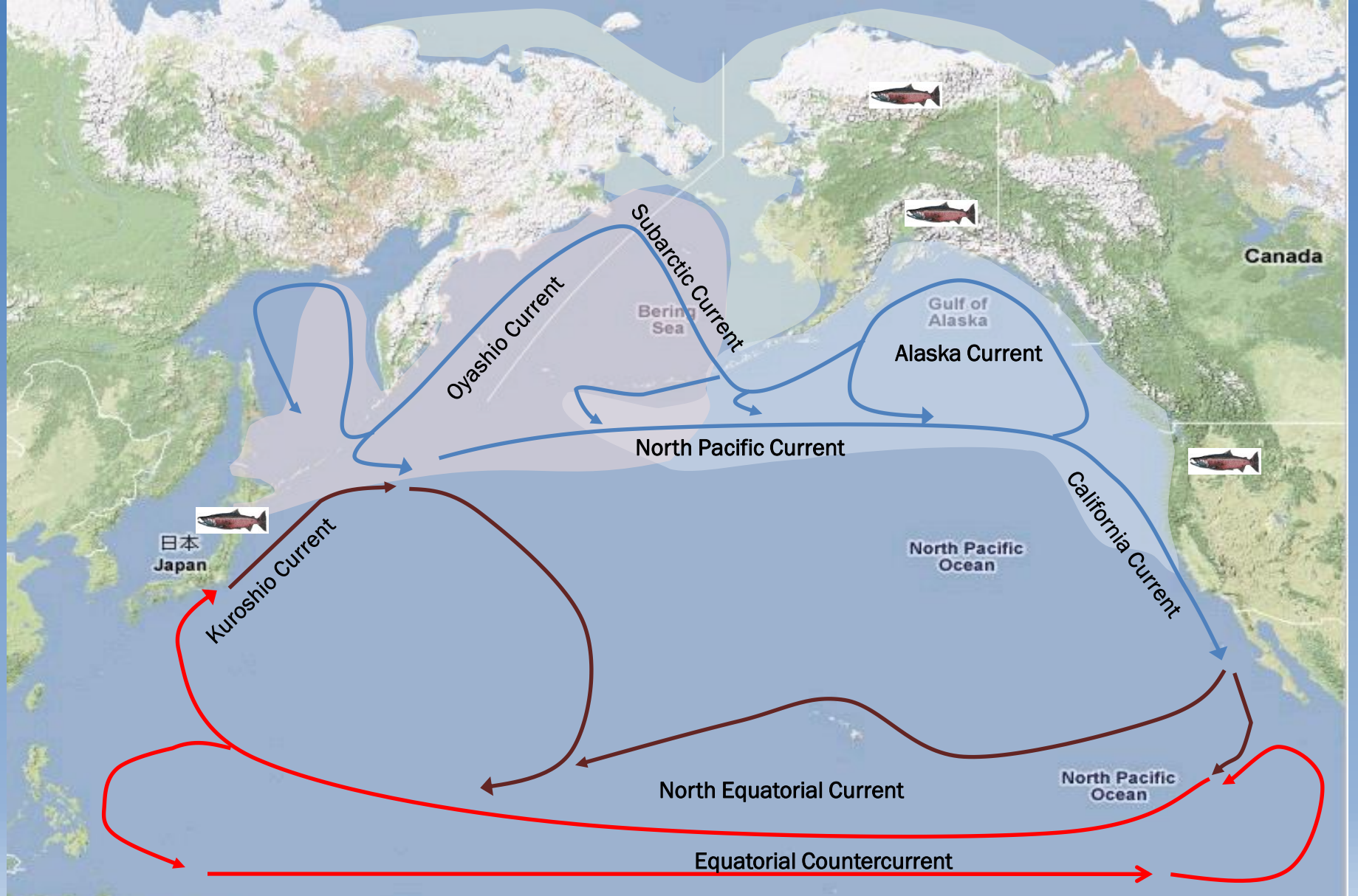


# Certain Things All Pacific Salmon Require for Survival

- Cold nutrient-rich ocean waters which support robust plankton blooms and numerous small fish.



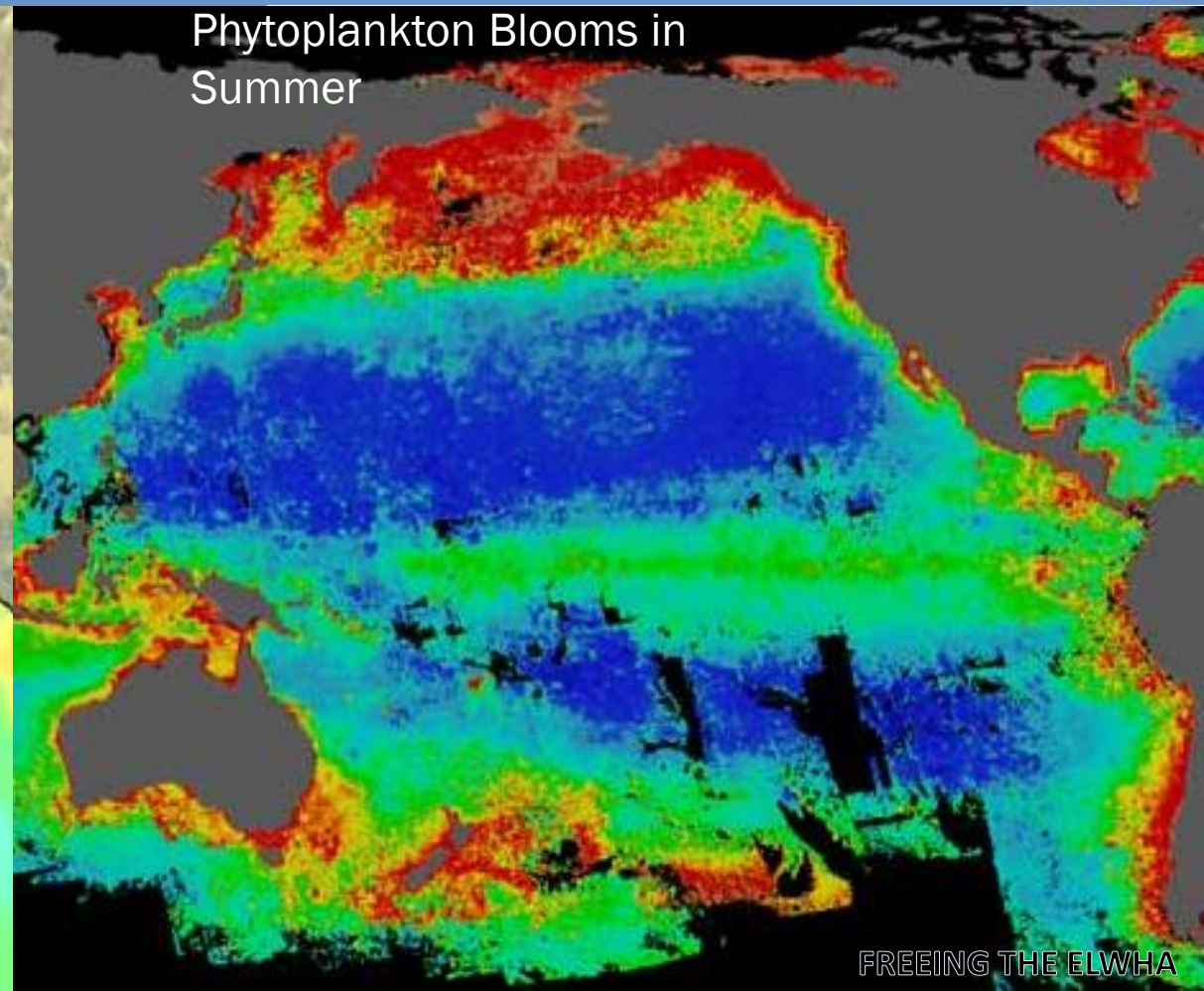
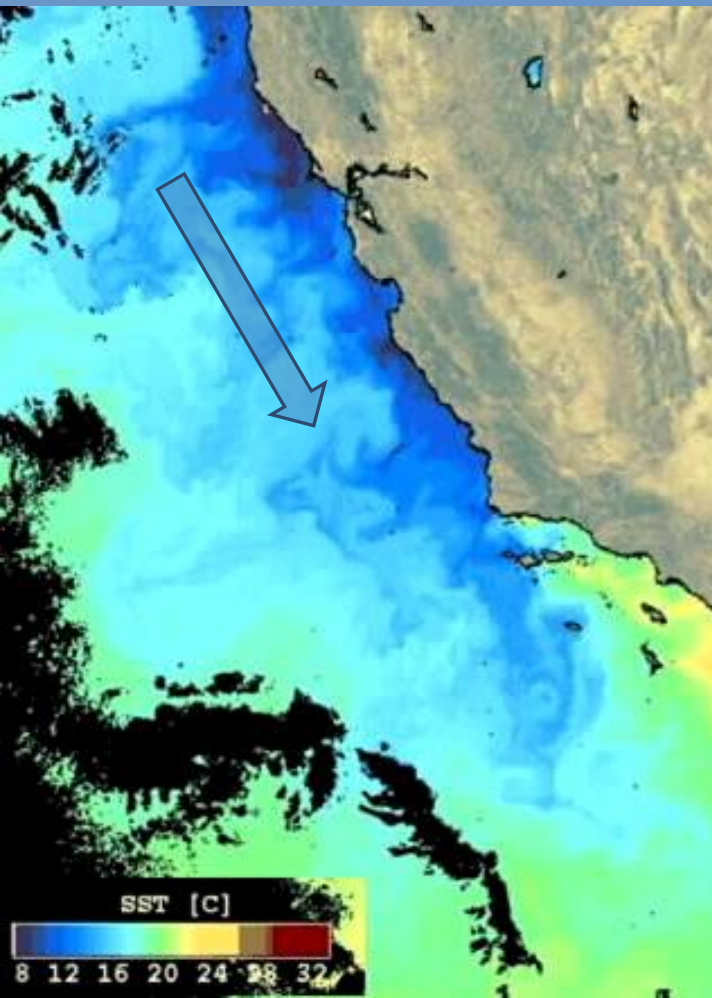

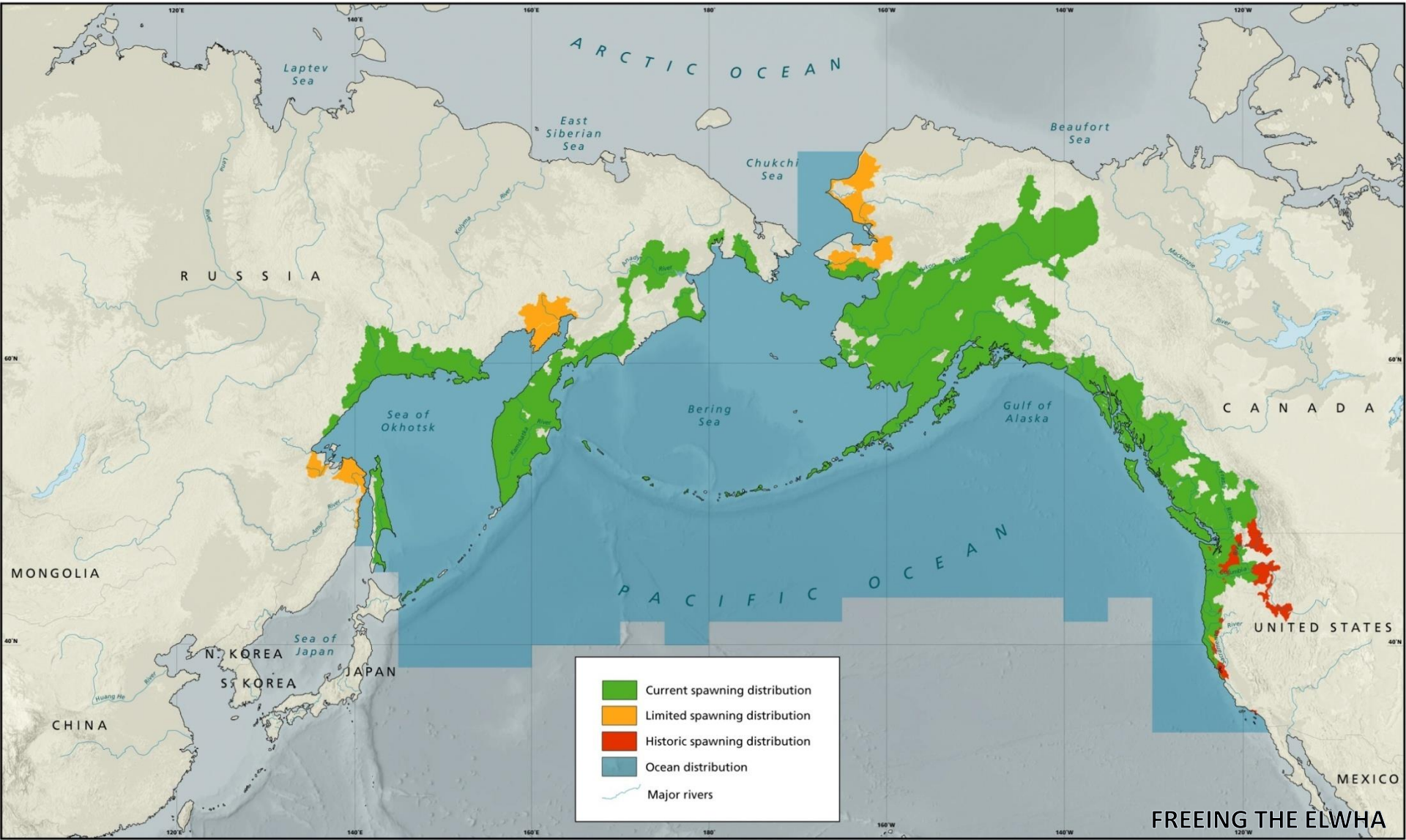

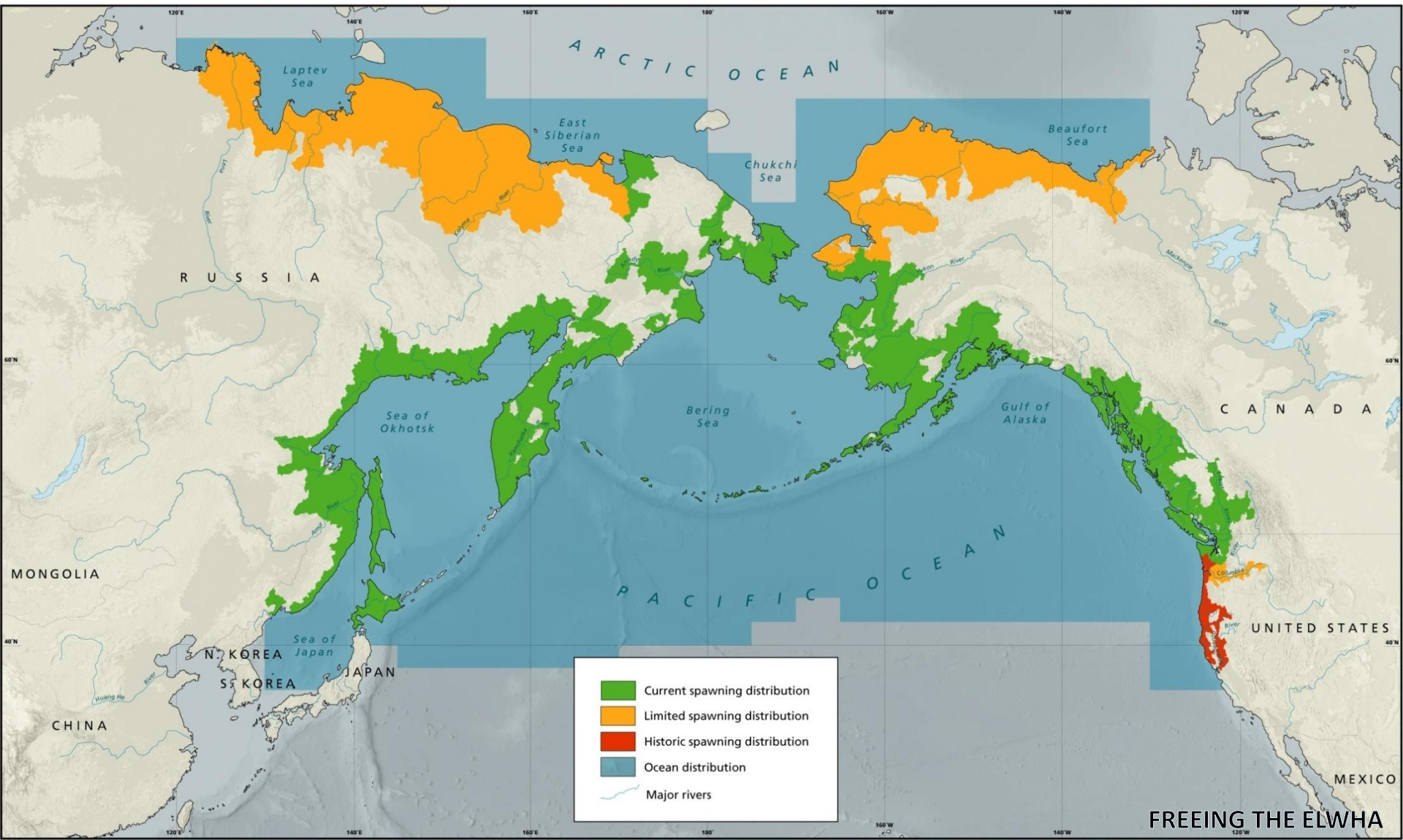

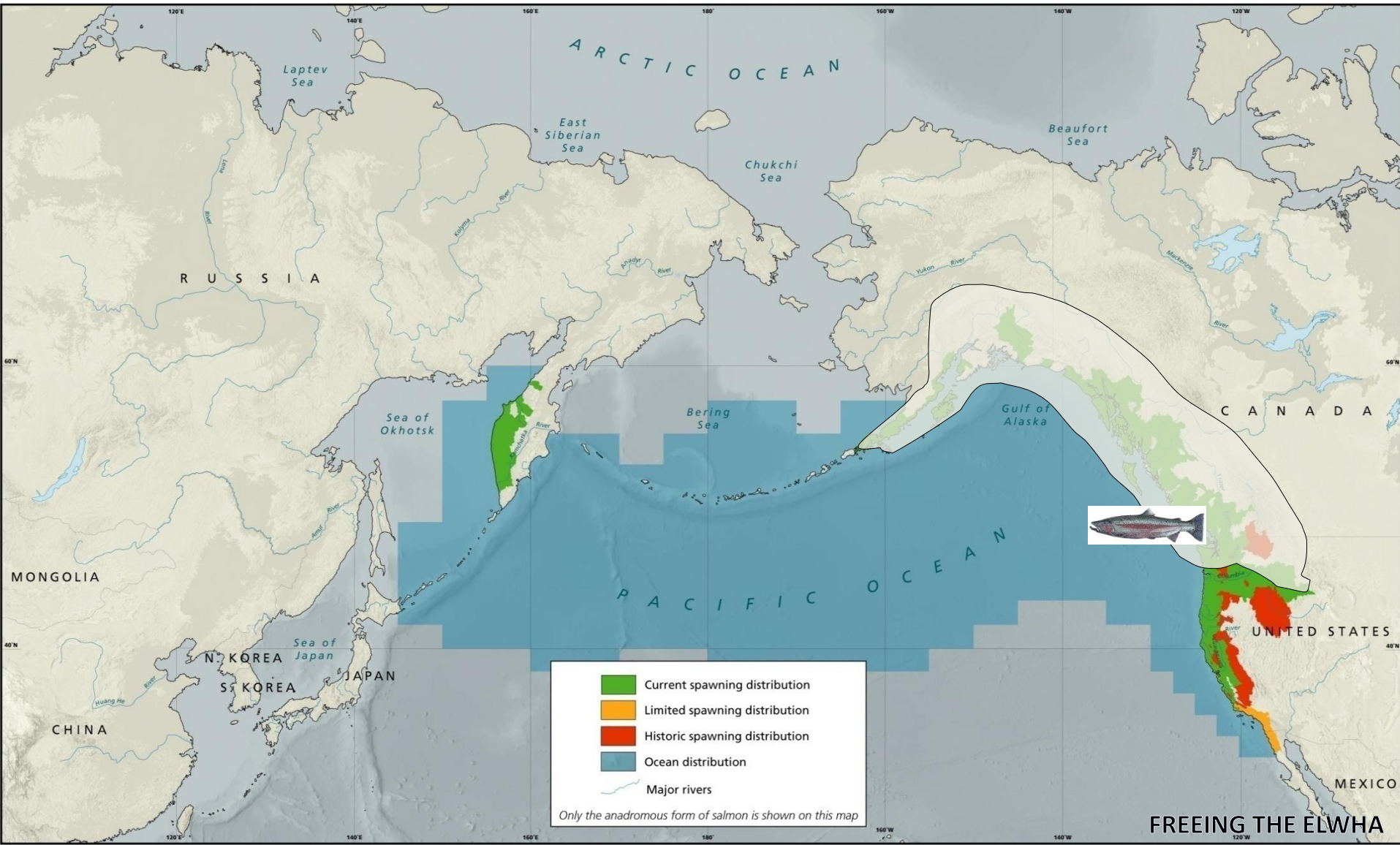

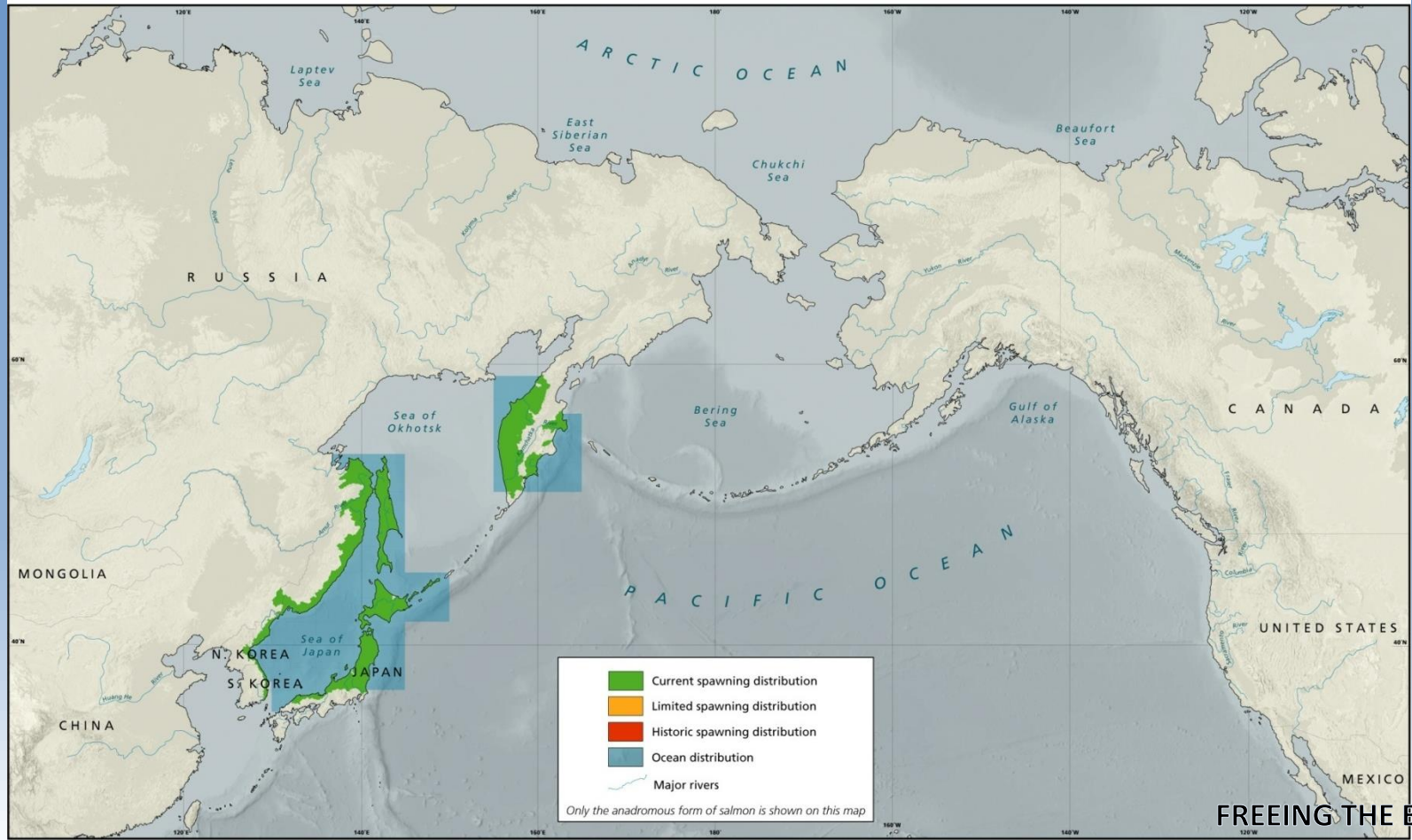
