Site-Visit Registration Form

We enjoy hosting groups and we look forward to your visit. Our presentations can be tailored to particular grades, ages, abilities and subject matter. Let us show you the rich history of Hope, and learn how it influenced President Bill Clinton as a young boy.

Site Amenities

- **Visitor Center** is accessible and can accommodate 75 visitors at a time. It is **free of charge**, and open from 9am to 4:30pm, 7 days a week.
- **Birthplace Home** tours are limited to 15 people per tour plus the Ranger. Tours are 15-30 minutes long. Food and/or drinks are not allowed in the Birthplace Home.
- **Garden area** between the two buildings can accommodate 200 people in favorable weather. There are two eight-foot picnic tables, one ten-foot bench and one bike rack available on the grounds. The lawn is maintained throughout the year. Fire ants are prevalent from March to November. Squirrels and small birds frequent the area for pecans and wild fruit-bearing trees. A rundown of the types of trees and vegetation on site is available on request.
- **Restrooms** are in a separate building on the property. The two restrooms are ADA-compliant. A public water fountain and bottle refill station is available on the outer wall of the restroom building.
- **Parking** is available for individual vehicles on Division Street, in front of the Visitor Center, in the West facing lane only. Bus parking is available in an overflow lot behind the site on Second Street, across from Atwood's Home and Ranch Supply Store.
- **Local restaurants and places of interest** include Tailgaters Restaurant, Melon Patch Restaurant and the Hope Train Station and Museum, which are approximately three blocks to the east of the Visitor Center on Division Street.
- **Fair City Park**, one mile and two minutes away by vehicle, is available for picnic areas, playground equipment and public restrooms.
- **Pre-trip site visit** is available for the planning staff upon request.
- **Gift shop** is located in the visitor center. A wide range of books and gifts are available for purchase.

We realize your time is valuable, so scheduling via email is anticipated and encouraged. Field trip scheduling is staffed on **Thursdays** from 9 am to 4 pm – you will hear back from us then.
