## **Option 1: Aquatic Invasive Species Video**

**Directions**: First, your group will create a plan for a short YouTube video. The video will focus on a specific aquatic invasive species and/or the effects of aquatic invasive species on the Sleeping Bear Dunes National Lakeshore. The video must also include a few ways that people can help to prevent the spread of aquatic invasive species or how they could get involved. After you have created your plan, practice the plan and record the video. The video can be shared with Sleeping Bear Dunes National Lakeshore and placed on their YouTube site.
