

Cedar Creek Water Level for Canoe Travel

Paddlers should register their float plans

<u><i>Water Level is:</i></u> <i>See USGS online</i>	<u><i>Then these are the conditions:</i></u>	<u><i>“What we would suggest:”</i></u>
2.5 ft or less	Very low water – many portages and impasses	Discourage Paddlers from attempting long trips
2.5-4 ft	OK – be prepared to carry your canoe from time to time	Cedar Creek Access to River-good floating
4 – 7 ft	Very good paddling Few portages	Full Steam ahead have fun and be safe
7-8 ft	Creek can overtop banks, esp. if Congaree River is high	Proceed with caution – navigation hard as channels widen, follow trail markers
8ft or higher	Flood Stage Conditions	Discourage Paddlers from attempting any trip
