**Today:** Partly cloudy this morning...then rain and snow this afternoon. Snow level 5000 feet this afternoon. Snow accumulation up to 1 inch. Highs in the mid 30s to mid 40s. Breezy. Southwest winds 15 to 25 mph with gusts to around 40 mph. Chance of precipitation near 100 percent.

**Tonight:** Rain and snow. Snow level 6500 feet lowering to 5000 feet after midnight. Snow accumulation of 2 to 3 inches. Lows in the mid 30s. Breezy. Southwest winds 15 to 25 mph with gusts to around 40 mph. Chance of precipitation near 100 percent.

**Tuesday:** Rain and snow. Snow level 5000 feet rising to 6500 feet in the afternoon. Snow accumulation up to 1 inch. Highs in the mid 30s to mid 40s. Breezy. Southwest winds 15 to 25 mph. Chance of precipitation near 100 percent.

**Tuesday Night:** Rain and snow. Snow level 7000 feet lowering to 4500 feet after midnight. Lows in the lower to mid 30s. West winds 15 to 20 mph becoming northwest 5 to 10 mph after midnight. Chance of precipitation near 100 percent.

**Wednesday:** Mostly cloudy with a 20 percent chance of rain and snow showers. Snow level 4500 feet in the morning. Highs in the mid 30s to mid 40s. Northeast winds around 5 mph shifting to the east 10 to 15 mph in the afternoon.

**Wednesday Night:** Mostly cloudy with a slight chance of rain and snow showers in the evening...then partly cloudy after midnight. Lows in the mid 20s to lower 30s.

**Thursday And Thursday Night:** Clear. Highs in the mid 30s to lower 40s. Lows in the mid 20s to lower 30s.

**Friday:** Sunny. Highs in the lower to mid 40s.
