### Be Aware of the Following Regulations:

- Group size is limited to 30 persons.
- Trailers and RVs are not allowed.
- The fee for the group site is \$30.00 per night and paid upon arrival.
- No motorized vehicles allowed past the group site.
- A day use permit is required to go beyond the group site for bike or foot traffic only. Permits can be obtained at the park visitor center or entrance station.
- To preserve the beauty of the campsite for future campers, we ask that you practice "low impact" camping:
  - Do not collect any fire wood or brush for campfires. You must bring your own fire wood from outside the Monument.
  - Campfires are only allowed in established campfire grate. Creating a campfire ring is prohibited.
  - Campfires may be prohibited during times of extreme fire danger.
  - Extinguish all campfires with water until cool to the touch.
  - Camp only on bare soil, not on vegetation.
  - When cleaning dishes, wipe food debris from dishes into the animal proof bins provided. Wash dishes away from the water faucet. Dispose of dirty dish water in brush well away from the main group site.
  - Do not leave food out. Secure food in animal proof containers or in a vehicle.
