Saturday, April 19

10:00 AM Wildflower Hike/Photography Workshop meet at campground amphitheater

Easy, one mile hike which will focus on wildflower identification and tips for capturing memorable images.

2:00 PM Wildflowers of Southern Appalachia visitor center auditorium

A look at wildflowers of the southern mountains through the lens of photographer Harold Jerrell.

7:00 PM Rare Plants of the Mountains and Plateaus visitor center auditorium

Close up look at some of the rare plants found in the region, presentation by photographer and author Thomas Barnes.

Sunday, April 20

10:00 AM Wildflower Identification and Folklore meet at campground amphitheater

Join park rangers on this easy, one mile walk along the Greenleaf Nature Trail which will showcase a wide variety of spring flowers and the colorful stories associated with them.

2:00 PM Wildflowers along the Ridge and Creek meet at the visitor center

Moderate 2 mile hike focusing on wildflowers found on the wooded ridges and along mountain streams.
