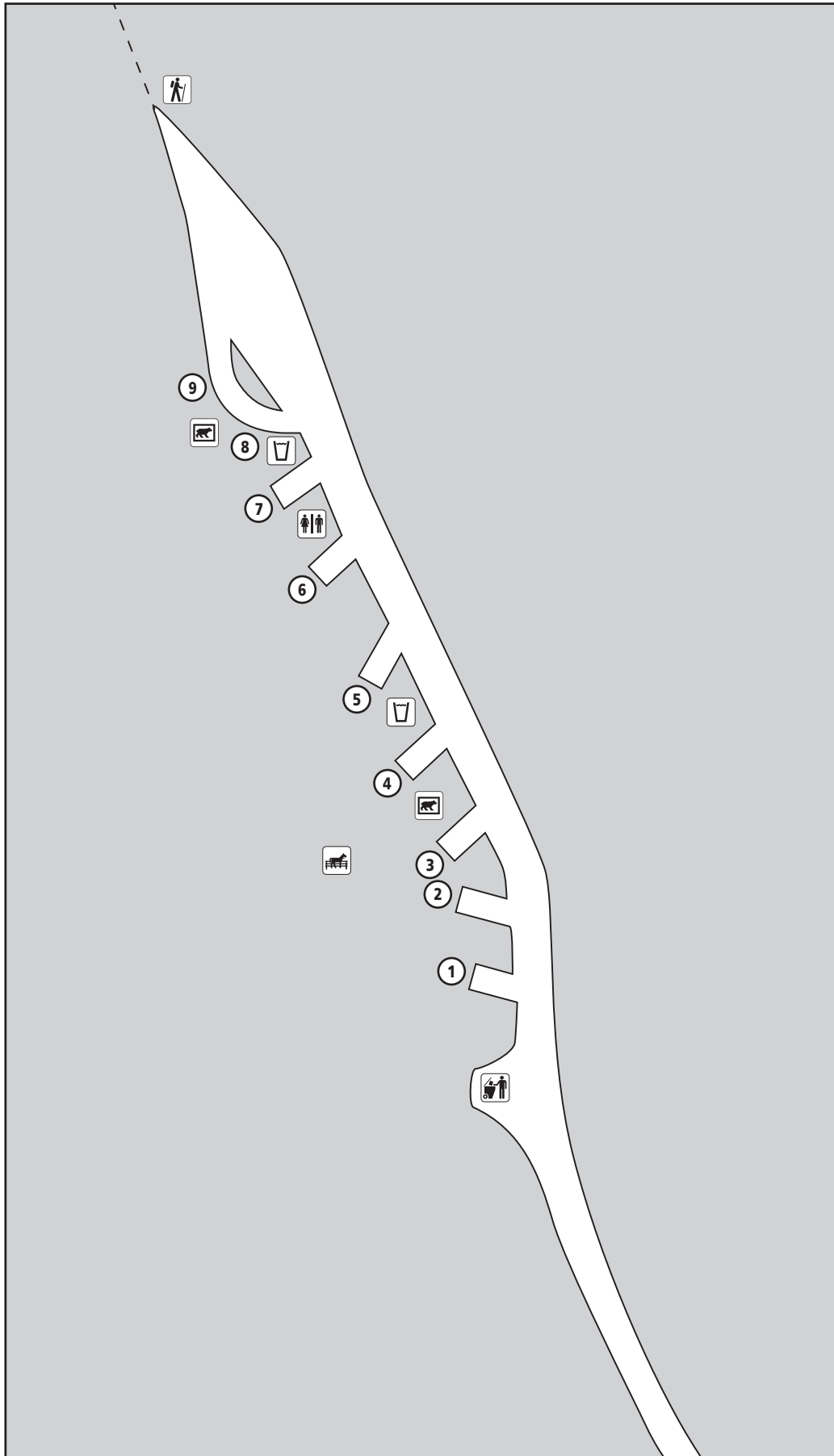


Dry Gulch Campground

Hammock Users:

- Use tree-saver straps or padding to protect tree bark.
- Do not use zip-ties around trees.
- Never nail or screw anything into trees.
- Take down your hammock when you leave campsite to prevent animals from getting tangled.
