Art @ M.D. Garage Season Announced

Brecksville, Ohio - Art @ M.D. Garage is a series of free art exhibitions coordinated by the Crooked River Gang, a volunteer group of regional artists founded by Cuyahoga Valley artist Don Getz. The National Park Service works cooperatively with the Crooked River Gang to promote artistic creation and exhibition in Cuyahoga Valley National Park (CVNP).

M.D. Garage was once a hub of activity in the historic village of Boston along the Ohio & Erie Canal. Closed in the 1980s, the 1946 Pure Oil Station was purchased by the National Park Service and restored in the late 1990s. The facility offers a unique open space for art exhibits and special events.
