### Popular Footbridge Closed in Cuyahoga Valley National Park

**Brecksville, Ohio** –Due to high water, the National Park Service announces the closure of the fiberglass footbridge that crosses over Brandywine Creek on the Brandywine Gorge Trail. The trail remains open but there is no detour to cross the creek to complete the loop trail. Visitors will need to backtrack on the trail to return to the parking lot.

Please respect all closures. The Brandywine Gorge Trail is accessible from Brandywine Falls, located at 8176 Brandywine Road, Sagamore Hills 44067. The area closes at dusk.
