Lindsay Lou & the Flatbelllys Take to the Happy Days Stage

Eclectic Americana from the Heart of America's Third Coast

Brecksville, Ohio – Cuyahoga Valley National Park (CVNP) is welcomes Michigan-based “rootsgrass” band Lindsay Lou & the Flatbelllys on Friday, November 14, 2014, at Happy Days Lodge. The concert begins at 8 p.m. Doors open at 7 p.m. The concert is part of the Cuyahoga Valley Heritage Series, presented by the National Park Service and the Conservancy for Cuyahoga Valley National Park, celebrating the cultural legacy of the Cuyahoga Valley. Lindsay Lou & the Flatbelllys is a young “rootsgrass” band with tight harmonies, instrumental expertise, and creative arrangements. From song to song, they weave the throwback sound of bluegrass instruments with striking blues vocals. Lindsay Lou & the Flatbelllys have been traversing the country with instruments in tow since the release of their 2012 record, *Release Your Shrouds*. The album showcased the band's meshing of Appalachian tradition with rootsy Michigan vigor. But wherever placed in the genre continuum, it is their sincerity and passion for following the music that propels this unique group.
