### **New Ranger-led Walks Offered Daily This Summer**

*Walks offered twice a day at Key Park Attractions*

**Brecksville, Ohio** – Starting Monday, June 1 through Monday, August 31, the National Park Service is offering daily ranger-guided walks at popular park attractions in Cuyahoga Valley National Park (CVNP). These one-hour walks will be held at Brandywine Falls, Beaver Marsh, and the Ledges.

**Explore Brandywine Falls** is a trip back in time. Stroll to one of the region's most scenic views, getting ranger insights into local geology and history. Leisurely pace. Accessible by wheelchair and stroller. The steep stairs are optional. Wednesdays, Saturdays, Sundays, 10 – 11 a.m. and 2 – 3 p.m.

**Explore Beaver Marsh** is an inspiring story of habitat recovery for those who to see wildlife. Leisurely pace. Accessible by wheelchair and stroller. Mondays and Thursdays, 9 – 10 a.m. and 11 a.m. – noon.

**Explore Ledges** takes you to stunning sandstone cliffs that attracted visitors long before CVNP was created. Leisurely pace. Tuesdays and Fridays, 10 – 11 a.m. and 2 – 3 p.m.
