Public Meetings for Draft White-tailed Deer Management Plan/ Environmental Impact Statement

Brecksville, Ohio - The National Park Service (NPS) published a Notice of Availability of the Draft White-tailed Deer Management Plan/ Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for a 60-day public review and comment period, beginning July 26, 2013 and ending September 24, 2013.

Public open house meetings will be held on Wednesday, August 14, 2013 from 1 to 3 p.m. or from 6 to 8 p.m. **All media are invited for interviews and questions beginning one hour prior to the public open house meetings.** All meetings will be held at Happy Days Lodge, 500 W. Streetsboro Road (State Route 303), 1-mile west of State Route 8, Peninsula, Ohio 44264.
