Short-term Closure for Valley Picnic Area and Plateau Trail Loop

Brecksville, Ohio – The National Park Service (NPS) announces a short-term closure of the Valley Picnic Area Parking Lot off Riverview Road in Cuyahoga Valley National Park (CVNP) for the replacement of the damaged culvert on the Plateau Trail. Closure is now in place until 5 p.m., Thursday, October 2, 2014. Access to the Plateau Trail is via the Oak Hill Trailhead, located at 3901 Oak Hill Road, 1.3 miles south of Major Road, Peninsula 44264. Visitors will be unable to complete the Plateau Trail Loop from either the Plateau Trail or the Oak Hill Trail. Detours are posted.

Please respect all park closures for the safety of visitors, resource, and park staff.
