A Cure for Cabin Fever Climb Aboard Cuyahoga Valley Scenic Railroad This Winter!

Peninsula, Ohio – Cuyahoga Valley Scenic Railroad (CVSR) is excited to announce a cure for cabin fever this January and February.

Starting January 10, 2009, “Cabin Fever” trains will depart on Saturdays and Sundays from Rockside Station in Independence at 10 a.m. and 1:30 p.m. and from Akron Northside Station at 11:35 a.m.

The *National Park Scenic* excursion is a 3-hour round trip allowing riders the opportunity to see the beauty of Cuyahoga Valley National Park in winter. Narration by a National Park Ranger on the historical significance of the area and the 33,000-acre Cuyahoga Valley National Park will be included each trip. Riders can choose to enjoy a layover in the Village of Peninsula or at the Canal Visitor Center. All tickets are only \$10.
