Cuyahoga Valley Scenic Railroad Cancels Service to Canton

Service from Peninsula to Akron continues

Brecksville, Ohio – Cuyahoga Valley Scenic Railroad (CVSR) has cancelled all train service between Akron Northside Station and Canton Station until further notice. The cancellation is due to early morning flash flooding that left debris on the tracks.

CVSR's service from Peninsula Depot to Akron Northside Station is not affected by the flooding and regularly scheduled service continues, Wednesdays through Sundays. Visit www.CVSR.com for schedule.
