Cuyahoga Valley Scenic Railroad Train Vandalized

Reward Offered for Information on Suspects

Brecksville, Ohio – During the evening on Tuesday, April 22, 2014, the engine on a Cuyahoga Valley Scenic Railroad train was vandalized while it was staged in Peninsula. Two unidentified males were observed attempting to set the train on fire. They fled on bicycles.
