Visitor Center Hours for Fall 2009

Brecksville, Ohio - Cuyahoga Valley National Park announces the following hours for park visitor centers for the months of September, October, and November.

Canal Visitor Center, located at 7104 Canal Road, at the intersection of Canal and Hillside Roads, in Valley View, will be open 10 a.m. - 4 p.m., daily. Exhibits illustrate 12,000 years of history in the valley, including the history of the Ohio & Erie Canal.

Boston Store Visitor Center, located at 1548 Boston Mills Road, east of Riverview Road, in Peninsula, will be open 10 a.m. - 4 p.m., Wednesdays through Sundays. This restored structure, built circa 1836, features interactive museum exhibits on canal boat building.

Frazer House, located at 7733 Canal Road in Valley View, is closed for stabilization repairs until further notice.

Hunt Farm Visitor Information Center, located at 2054 Bolanz Road, between Riverview and Akron-Peninsula Roads, in Peninsula, will be open 10 a.m. - 4 p.m., Saturdays and Sundays. Hunt Farm reflects the image of the small family farms that operated in the valley during the late 19th century.

Peninsula Depot Visitor Center, located at 1630 Mill Street, in Peninsula, will be open 9 a.m. - 7 p.m., Wednesdays through Sundays in September and October, and 10 a.m. - 4 p.m., Saturdays and Sundays in November. This late 19th-century boarding station of the Valley Railway offers basic information and orientation for visitors to the village, park, Cuyahoga Valley Scenic Railroad, and Ohio & Erie Canalway.

CVNP encompasses 33,000 acres along the Cuyahoga River between Cleveland and Akron. Managed by the National Park Service, CVNP combines cultural, historical, recreational, and natural activities in one setting.
