### **Cuyahoga Valley National Park Reopens the Entire Towpath Trail**

*Train service to Canton and Bike Aboard! service restored*

**Brecksville, Ohio** – The National Park Service has reopened all of the Ohio & Erie Canal Towpath Trail in Cuyahoga Valley National Park (CVNP) that was closed due to flooding conditions.

Cuyahoga Valley Scenic Railroad (CVSR) service from Akron Northside Station to Canton Station resumes Saturday, July 23, 2011.

Bike Aboard! Service continues as scheduled between Peninsula and Akron.
