Current Flooding Conditions

Brecksville, Ohio - Flooding has occurred overnight due to rainfall and melting snow in Cuyahoga Valley National Park. Assessments of cultural and natural resources were made by park staff throughout the night and will continue today.

Visitor centers are open and public programs will continue as scheduled.

At this time the current locations and roads are closed until further notice:

- Riverview Road extension
- Vaughn Road at Riverview Road intersection
- Highland Road near Vaughn Road
- Lock 29 Parking lot in Peninsula

Please respect all closed areas for visitor and resource safety. Avoid driving in flooded roadways. The water may be deeper than it appears. Please turn around and locate another route.

Cuyahoga Valley National Park (CVNP) encompasses 33,000 acres along the Cuyahoga River between Cleveland and Akron. Managed by the National Park Service, CVNP combines cultural, historical, recreational, and natural activities in one setting.
