Dixieland Sound to Fill the Valley

Brecksville, Ohio –The Peninsula Jazz Festival comes to Happy Days Lodge in Cuyahoga Valley National Park on Sunday, April 19, from 2 - 5 p.m. The festival is presented twice yearly by the Peninsula Library and Historical Society and features New Orleans jazz musicians from around the region. The event is free and open to the public. A shuttle from Happy Days Lodge parking lot is available to take visitors to the door.

Happy Days Lodge, located at 500 West Streetsboro Road (State Route 303) in Peninsula, 1 mile west of State Route 8, is a restored Civilian Conservation Corps structure that provides a rustic ambiance for folk and traditional concerts, theater, lectures, and ranger-led programs.

CVNP encompasses 33,000 acres along the Cuyahoga River between Cleveland and Akron. Managed by the National Park Service, CVNP combines cultural, historical, recreational, and natural activities in one setting.
